

## **Amber and Munken Kraft paper grades to come in contact with food and meet toys safety requirements**

Amber is wood-free, uncoated graphic paper. Only primary fibers from certified sources are used for its production. Ground calcium carbonate is used as filler.

Munken Kraft is a machine finished bleached kraft paper. The mixture of hardwood and softwood virgin fibre, provides Munken Kraft excellent runability and high strenght. The sized surface enables outstanding printability.

Amber and Munken Kraft paper grades are produced in accordance with the following legal acts:
