

Statement

Amber and Munken Kraft RoHS EU directive, SVHC, mineral oils

Hereby Arctic Paper Kostrzyn confirms that according to the information from APK Technology and Development Department, all Amber and Munken Kraft paper grades are in accordance with PCP EU Directive 91/173/EEC, RoHS II EU Directive 2011/65 and RoHS III Directive 2015/863.

Produced by Arctic Paper Kostrzyn Amber and Munken Kraft paper grades do not include any Substances of Very High Concern (SVHC), which are listed on European Chemicals Agency List. They are in accordance with EU Directives 2023/988, 2018/588, 2018/589, 2018/636, 2018/852 with supplements 99/42/EC, 99/177/EC and 2009/48/EC as well.

We use neither PBB (polybrominated biphenyls) nor PVC (polyvinyl chloride), PBDE (polybrominated diphenyl ethers), PFOS (perfluorooctanesulfonic acid), DMF (dimethylfumarat), BPA (bisphenol A), BPF (bisphenol F), BPS (bisphenol S), chlorine, biphenyls, PAA (primary aromatic amines), PFOA (perfluorooctanoic acid), PCP, PFA, PFC, PFAS, PFCA, PFSA, DFMA, DEHP, DBP, BBP, DIBP, TriCP, TeCPan, APEOs, phthalates, benzenes, latex, formaldehyds in the process of paper production.

They are not present in the furnish and chemical additions also, as we know from their adequate specifications.

Amber and Munken Kraft paper grades do not include mineral oils (MOAH/MOSH), EDC, persistent organic pollutants (POPs) and NIAS substances
